

Chautauqua Lake Partnership  
**Community Outreach 2018**

The Chautauqua Lake Partnership (Partnership) has depended on grassroots community support and municipality leadership for its efforts. This has been most apparent in 2017 and 2018 invasive weed management efforts involving herbicides. Overwhelming public support, unwavering leadership by the Town of Ellery as SEIS Lead Agency and supportive SEIS Findings and permit applications by the Towns of Ellery, Ellicott, Busti and North Harmony and the Village of Celoron complemented significant funding from individuals, businesses and three local foundations in support of 2017 and 2018 Partnership initiatives.

The Partnership's support and the Town of Ellery's leadership was successful in returning herbicides to the Chautauqua Lake weed management toolkit after a 25-year absence. 2018 herbicide treatments, although limited by arbitrary DEC permit limitations and lack of adequate funding, were successful. The Partnership has received an overwhelmingly positive response from individuals in those areas which were treated along with pleas for help from areas which did not receive treatment.

The attached document titled **"Interested in Voicing Your Concern About Lake Water Conditions??"** provides guidance and informational resources to facilitate your individual action and voice with Town, Village, County, State and DEC representatives. **To be clear, to get the necessary support for continuation of herbicide-based weed management in Chautauqua Lake you all must begin immediately, before summer is over and many leave for the season...**

- Call or visit and voice your support to your Town, Village, County and State representatives (contact information is included in the attachment)
- Gather your neighbors or go individually and speak in support at meetings of Town and Village Boards and the County Legislature (contact information is included in the attachment)
- Write letters in support to Town, Village, County, State and DEC representatives (sample letters are included in the attachment)

You'll have an opportunity to voice your concerns and requests at the **County's Chautauqua Lake Rally** at The Village Casino in Bemus Point on August 18, 2018, 9:00 am – noon.

And, most importantly, we need you to participate in the **Partnership's Labor Day Rally** at The Village Casino in Bemus Point on Saturday, September 1, 9:00 - 11:00 am. A portion of the Rally will be dedicated to reporting out on your efforts. If possible, attend the Rally with members of your community as a group. This has however, become increasingly difficult if not impossible due to the deteriorating condition of the lake water. The proliferation of invasive weeds has developed to the point that swimming is impossible, fishing is difficult and the use of a power boat has been reduced to constant stop and go to remove weeds from the prop or, in some cases, to get towed to a marina for expensive repairs. Weed harvesting is not a solution and in some ways makes the situation worse. In locations where herbicides have been permitted, funded and used there has been significant improvement. It is time for action to eliminate this problem.

We need our county to support town and village herbicide permitting and assist New York State and Chautauqua Lake shoreline Towns and Villages in funding the targeted use of herbicides. I own property along Chautauqua Lake in \_\_\_\_\_ and contribute to the local economy by paying property taxes, school taxes, and income taxes as well as patronizing local stores and restaurants. I am invested in ensuring that Chautauqua Lake remains the jewel of Chautauqua County and a frequent destination for in state and out of state tourists. However, the proliferation of invasive weeds in Chautauqua Lake is threatening the lakes use for recreational pursuits and aesthetic enjoyment. I have first-hand experience that recreational use of the lake has become increasingly difficult if not impossible due to the deteriorating condition of the lake water. The increasing density of invasive weeds has made swimming impossible, fishing difficult, and the use of a power boat has been reduced to constant stop and go to remove weeds from the prop. Weeds have also led, in some cases, to boats being towed to a marina for expensive repairs.

I recognize that millions of dollars have been invested in harvesting weeds in the lake, but weed harvesting has proven not to be the solution. In fact, in some ways, harvesting has made the situation worse.

On the other hand, I have noticed a distinct difference in the quality of lake water in areas in which herbicides were applied this past June and where no herbicide application has taken place. 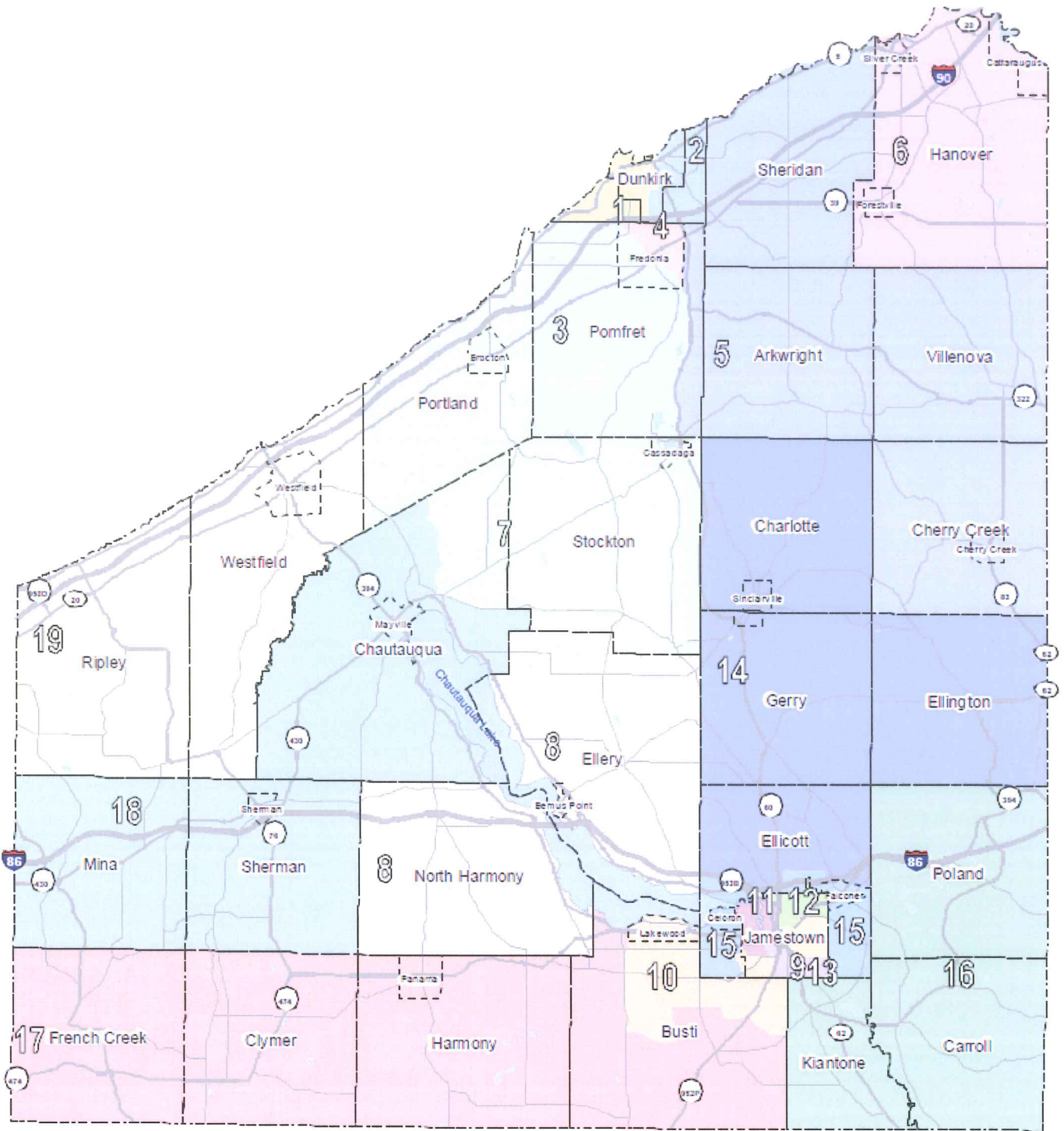

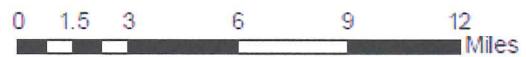
